

# Clays Details

- WS (White Stoneware)

White firing, super fine porcelain type clay. Fires up to cone 8.

- TR-1

Stoneware: Light coloured superfine clay, fires cream up to cone 8, light grey at cone 9 –10.

- 1g20m

Light coloured 20 mesh grogged clay, fires cream up to cone 8, light grey at cone 9 –10.

- 2F

Light coloured, fires cream up to cone 8, light grey at cone 9 –10. with addition of dust free 60# grog, giving a more open body which is not hard on the hands.

- 2FW

Light coloured, fires cream up to cone 8, light grey at cone 9 –10. Contains dust free 60# grog, giving it a more open body which is not hard on the hands and refractory materials for extra strength. Ideal for large platters, etc.

- 3

Fires dark brown / black at higher temperature with 0-1 mm grog. Beautiful for sculpture and handwork, fired without glaze to 1260,,a - Black clay. Recommended to fire from (1120C - 1220C)

- 3s6g

Dark brown with grog. Fires to cone 8. (1260C)

- TR-5

Excellent throwing clay, giving warm texture to final glaze. Fires cream with manganese speckle at cone 8, darker grey with speckle at cone 9-10.

- 5g/0mm to 1mm grog

Fires cream with manganese speckle at cone 8, darker grey with speckle at cone 9 to 10. Has 0mm to 1mm grog.

- 5L

Fires to cream / buff colour. Excellent for throwing – has no speckle.

- 6g

Red throwing clay but with addition of coarse 10# grog. Fires (1050C - 1260C)

- TR-7

Mixture of white and terra-cotta clay. Fires warm brown from cone 6 – 7, grey-brown at cone 9 –10.

- R

We recycle your used clay, everything together, red and white, resulting in a warm brown plastic clay at a great price.

- P-82

Warm buff coloured clay fired at cone 6 – 7, more grey at cone 8 – 9.

- G Clays

Grey firing with or without grog, (1120C - 1220C)

- FC12GW

Light colored clay, fires cream up to cone 8, light grey at cone 9 –10. Especially formulated for extra refractory strength.

- DMCW

Biscuit color – grogged clay. Fires to cone 8 (1260C). More stony at higher temperature.

- DMCL

Light firing grogged. Fires to cone 8. (1260C)
